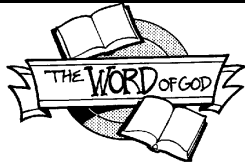

## Do We Have Our Priorities In Order? I Kings 3:11-12

The theme for the month of June is "*Now is the acceptable time to include God in our daily decisions.*" In other words, making God a priority in our daily lives: keeping him the focal and the center point in all we do. You have heard me say many times that the choices/decisions we make are key to the priorities we practice. The importance of such choices cannot be overestimated. As some of us heard, if you want to know what you will be like in the future, just look at the choices/decisions you are making today. Think about these two thoughts:

- "What you are today (*based on choices you are making*) is what you are becoming. If God is not involved, then that is a scary thought.
- "You are today what you have been becoming (*based on choices you have already made*)."

Our choices--which reflect our priorities--will determine whether or not we fulfill God's design for our life **I Corinthians 6:19-20, II Corinthians 6:16.** Getting everything done--or deciding what does not need to be done--is a matter of choice. Whether you are dealing with the next five minutes, next hour, tomorrow, next week, or next month, the choices you/we make, make all the differences in the world!

When Solomon realizes that some of the choices/decisions he was making was not a priority, he turned to God, asking for wisdom--a discerning heart in making daily choices/decisions. **I Kings 3**
